STANDING ORDER

The Court hereby directs that, until further notice, the West Virginia Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation's regional jails, correctional centers, and correctional facilities screen all detainees who are scheduled to appear in the Northern District of West Virginia to determine their body temperature. Such screening shall take place reasonably prior to the detainee's court appearance. If the temperature is 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or above, such detainees should not be produced, and the Court shall be forthwith notified.

The Clerk's Office is DIRECTED to transmit a copy of this Order to the U.S. Marshals Service.
